General Summary:

Under the supervision of the Superintendent of Public works, performs a variety of duties in the township including water and sewer construction, park maintenance, garbage collection, cutting grass, removing snow, and working in cemetery. Sets up and maintains seasonal park equipment.

Typical Duties:

- Assists in repair, maintenance, and installation of water service lines and facilities.
Helps with thawing frozen water lines.
- Assists in maintenance and installation of sewer lines. Helps with power rodding of sewer lines and rooting from homes to sewer main.
- Flushes sewer lines as directed. Also may flush fire hydrants as needed.
- Sets up and maintains park equipment. Takes down and stores seasonal equipment.
- Mows grass in parks, playgrounds, boulevard, and other township property.
- Removes snow from sidewalks near township buildings and around fire hydrants.
- Works on refuse packer as tail gunner or driver when needed.
- Assists in digging and covering graves in cemetery.
- Regularly uses hand and power tools, hand and riding lawn mowers, garbage packer, chain saws, portable generators, sprinklers.
- Performs other related duties as required.

The above statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed by people assigned this classification. They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all job duties performed by personnel so classified.
