WHEREAS, The Marquette County Road Commission (MCRC) and Superior Extrusion Inc. are partnering to secure funds from a Michigan Transportation Economic Development Fund Category "A" Grant,

WHEREAS, the cost to Relocate Avenue G is \$300,000

WHEREAS, \$300,000 is unavailable locally to Relocate Avenue G,

WHEREAS, Superior Extrusion Inc. will be in Marquette County and produce over 30 local jobs,

WHEREAS, Superior Extrusion Inc and the MCRC desire a safe and reliable all-season road to access Superior Extrusion's complex,

WHEREAS, Avenue G is under MCRC jurisdiction and Avenue G will provide access for the complex,

WHEREAS, Superior Extrusion Inc is willing to contribute matching funds so the MCRC can apply for a Category "A" Grant to relocate Avenue G to provide a safe and reliable all-season road,

WHEREAS, the requirement of the Category "A" Grant process is to get a resolution of support from all local townships in which Category A improvements are taking place,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forsyth Township Board does hereby support MCRC's Category "A" Grant to relocate Avenue G to an all-season road standard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be made a part of the minutes of the Forsyth Township Board, and that a copy be sent to the Marquette County Road Commission for their Category "A" Application for Avenue G.
