

**FORSYTH TOWNSHIP, MARQUETTE COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
ORDINANCE AMENDING FISCAL YEAR ORDINANCE**

**Ordinance No. 5-2019**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Forsyth Township, Marquette County, Michigan, held at the Gwinn Community Center on June 27, 2019 at 6:30 p.m., Township Board Member Supervisor Joseph Boogren moved to adopt the following ordinance, which motion was seconded by Township Board Member Trustee Chris Adams.

*An ordinance to amend Forsyth Township Ordinance No. 4-79, entitled "Fiscal Year Ordinance," to remove requirements for the Township Board to conduct an annual settlement day meeting and an annual meeting of the electorate, consistent with State law, and repeal any ordinance or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance.*

FORSYTH TOWNSHIP, MARQUETTE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 4-79, SECTION III:** Ordinance No. 4-79, Section III, shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION III

Repealed by Ordinance No. 5-2019.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 4-79, SECTION IV:** Ordinance No. 4-79, Section IV, shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION IV

The annual meeting of the electorate of Forsyth Township is hereby abolished pursuant to the provisions of MCL 41.8 and other applicable laws and ordinances.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall only affect the particular provisions, section or part involved in such decision and shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of such Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4. REPEAL.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions or parts of any resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the date of its publication.
